

Key Factors affecting urban water governance






Multi-level governance gaps: Capacity and Funding gaps

Capacity







Policy Responses : The 3Ps co-ordination framework





Next steps : implementation of the OECD Principles on Water Governance at city level




Endorsed by OECD's 34 Member States at the Ministerial Council Meeting on 4 June 2015
