Keep Sweden Tidy is a hub that build networks, gather knowledge, operate opinion, and offer concrete solutions and tools to prevent and reduce litter.


Marine litter facts

• 80% comes from land-based sources, from you and me in urban areas.

• 85% are found below the surface not visible for us.

• Most of it constitute of plastics.

• Plastic may leak hazardous substances to the marine environment.


