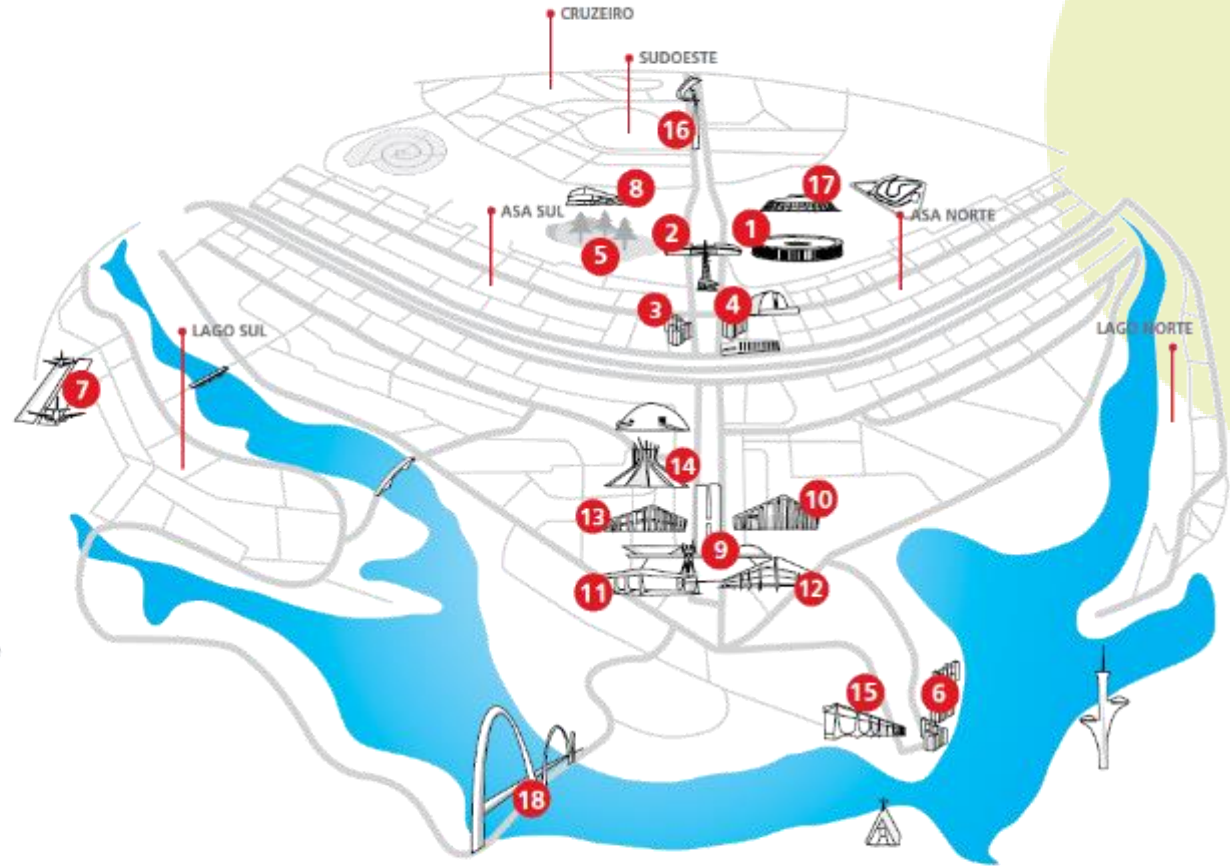

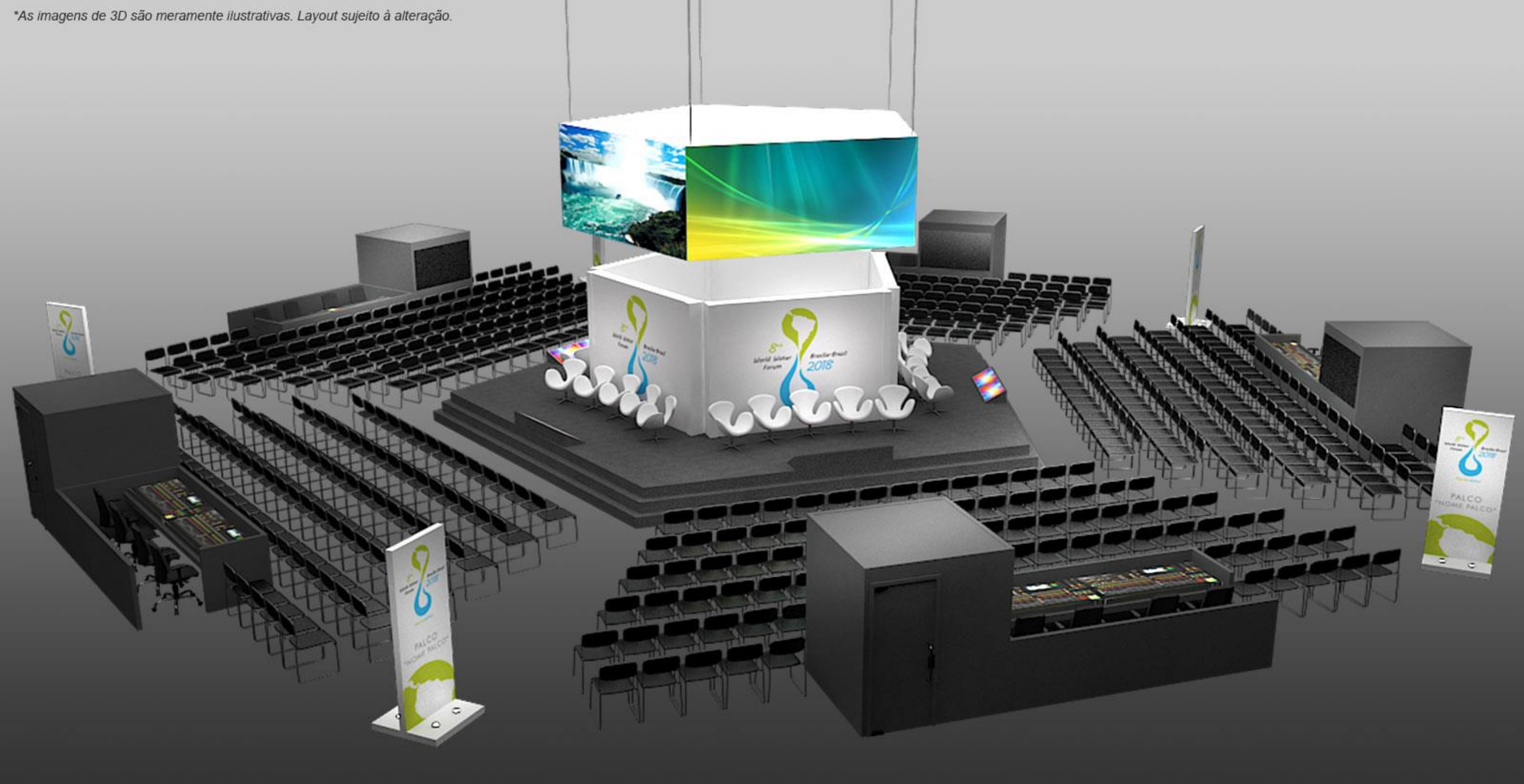

\*Footbridge authorization is being undertaken

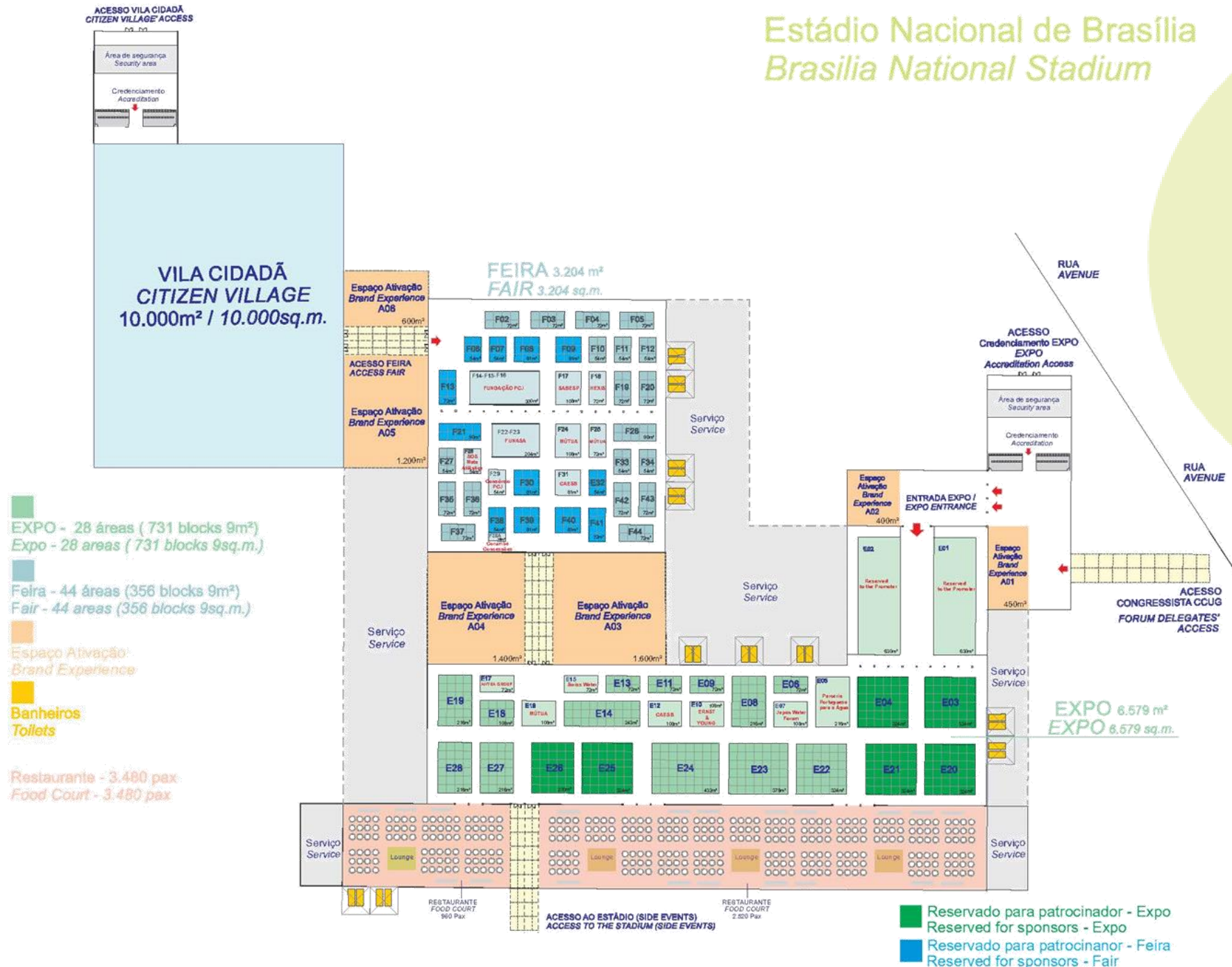

## Thematic Process

Stakeholders get together to propose solutions for priority issues, establishing goals to be achieved by multiple organizations

## Regional Process

6 regions (Africa, Americas, Asia-Pacific, Europa , Mediteranean, and Arab-North Africa) and 13 sub-regions identifies local/regional good practices and mobilize stakeholders in a participative process

## Political Process

Governors/Ministers/Local Authorities, Parliamentarians and Judges and Prosecutors developing political goals and proposing solutions

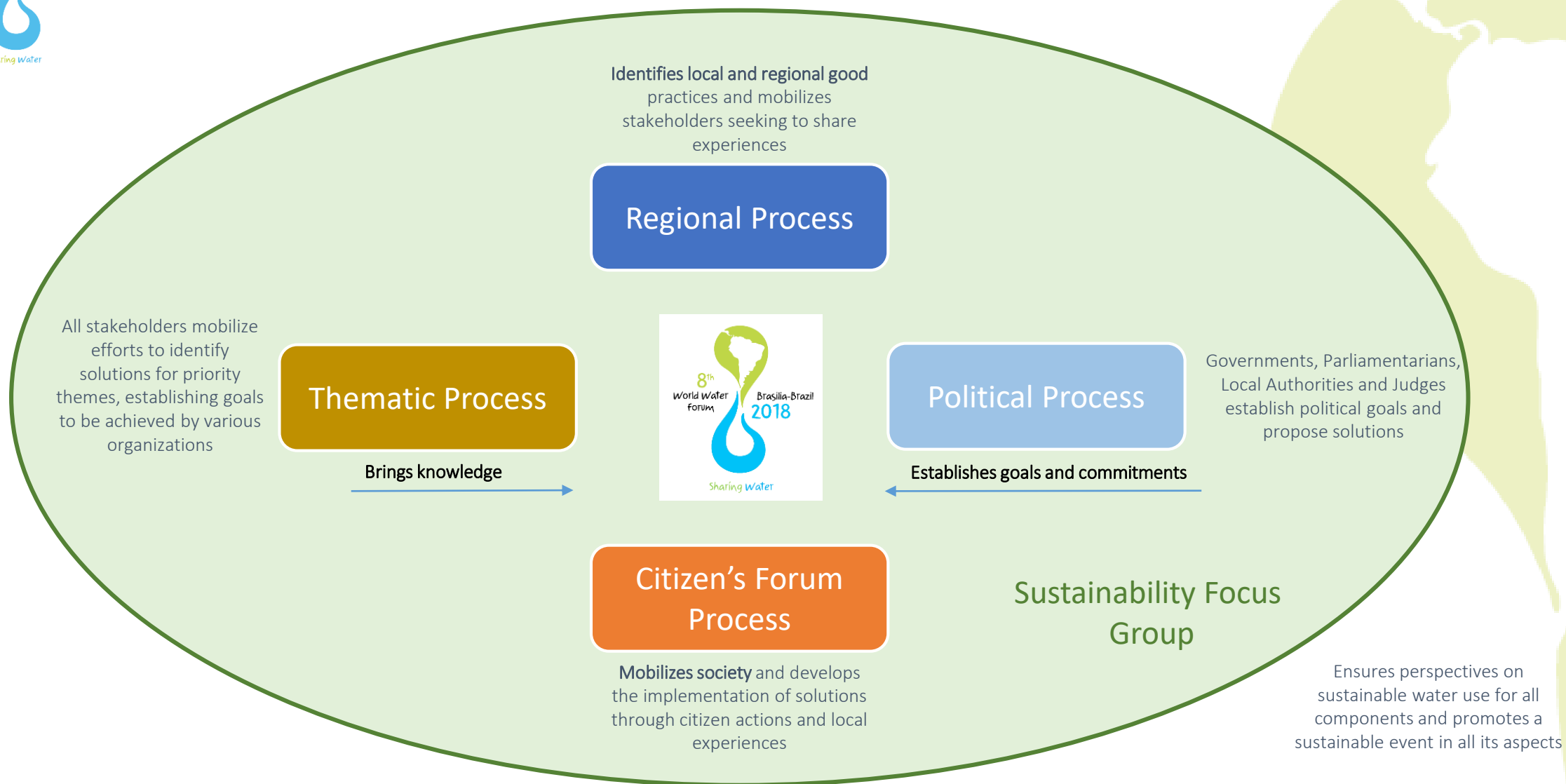
## Citizen's Forum Process
