Intersectoral cooperation


- Create sustainable infrastructures/systems

Genuine leadership


- Managers and leaders in society and organisations must be carriers of the visions and goals






Man made wetlands give multiple values

• Strive for a market where it is good business to save energy and natural resources.


From "how much can the environment stand?"

Example of new version infrastructure for sustainable waste water treatment




The Södertälje model
