

MOVING TOWARD CONCEPT TO REALITY (BABY WASH FIELD TESTING)

Intervention Area



Gowainghat, Bangladesh

- 13,500 mothers with U5 Child
- Under Weight Rate 34.6%
- Stunted Rate 48.0%
- Wasting Rate 9.9%
- U5 Child with diarrhea in last 2 weeks
 -5.4%
- Improved Drinking water sources –
 83.8%
- Improved Sanitation facilities 63.5%
- Safe Disposal of Child feaces 39.0%




BABY WASH (Field Testing in Bangladesh)

Targeted Audience

- Primary audience: Mothers of under two years of children, Lactating mothers, pregnant women and caregivers
- Secondary audience: Fathers of under two years of children, mother in laws, health workers, family planning workers and high school girls.
- Tertiary audience: Union Parishad, Community support group of Community Clinic and community clinic as well.
