# Kenya: Legal & regulatory framework vs. reality

- Right to Water in the Constitution
- County governments in charge of water services
- WASREB in charge of protecting consumer interests & rights
- National standards & guidelines based on human rights
- Licensing procedures for service providers
- Services in rural areas mostly community managed
- Community groups lack legal status
- Community groups act in isolation and do not report
- Services are poor and expensive
- Asset ownership unclear
- 1 in 3 community water systems stops functioning in first 3 years

## IMPLEMENTATION PHASE

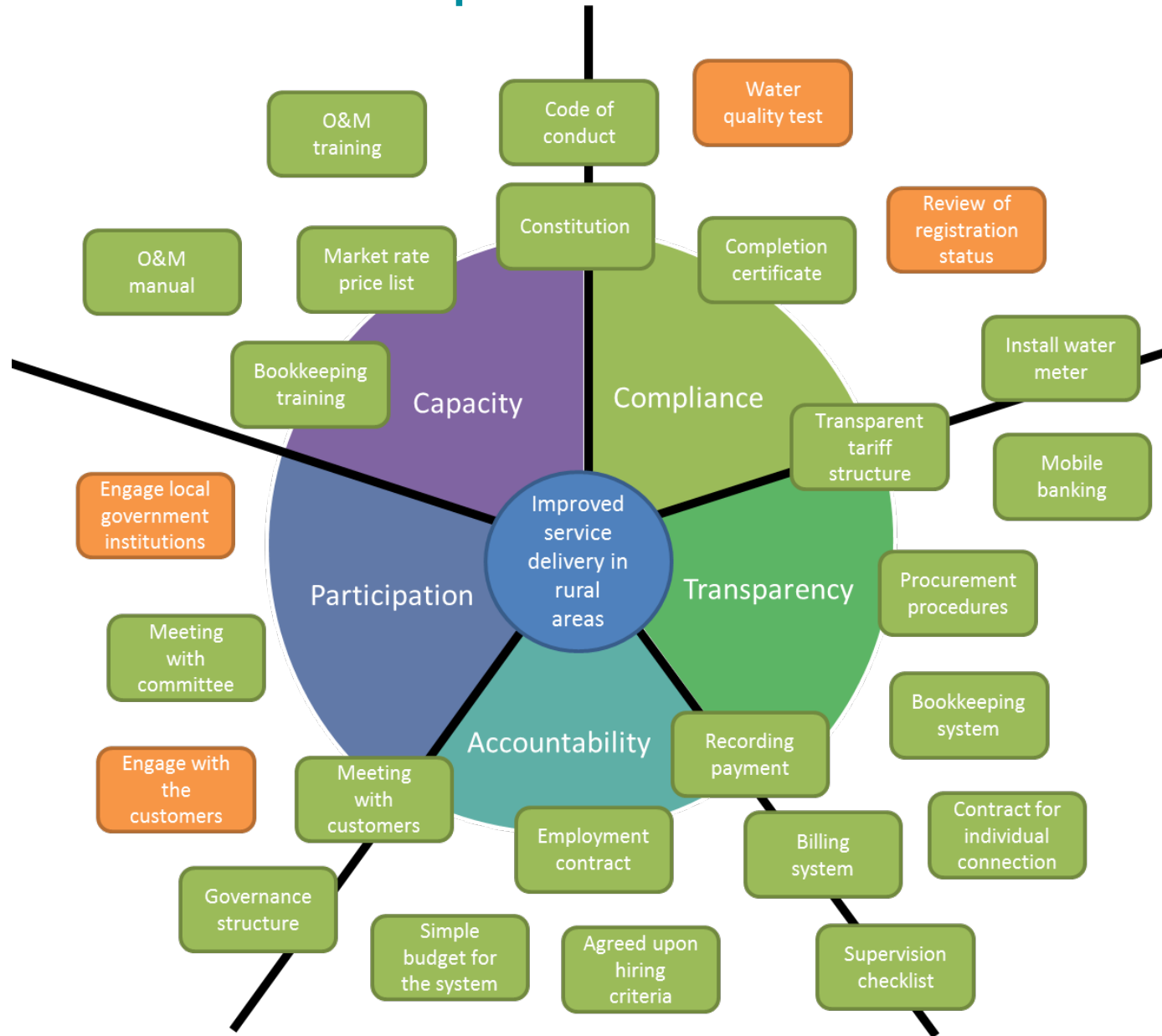
- Implementation of tools
- Transition towards appropriate management model
- Follow-up & coaching

# Multi-Level Engagement

- Policy dialogue with WASREB, MWI, County Governments
- Support to WASREB in developing management models for commercially unviable areas, simplified standards and KPIs
- Support capacity development for county governments provided by WASREB and MWI in disseminating Water Act 2016
- IM Toolbox application at local level:
  - detailed guidance & coaching on management of water systems
  - Piloting in 5 small water systems
  - Learning and feedback among actors in CoP
