"DAKAR 2021": A NEW VISION OF WWF



- A more focused, inclusive WWF, a catalyst for action on water and sanitation commitments.
- A socially, politically and economically effective WWF.
- A contextualized and connected WWF: links with other platforms and international frameworks (SDGs, Paris Agreement, Africa Water Vision 2025, Africa Agenda 2063, etc.)



"DAKAR 2021": A NEW PROCESS




- Integrated process, focusing on four priority themes:
 - Water security,
 - Cooperation,
 - Water & Rural development,
 - Means and tools (Innovation, governance, etc.).
- Process facilitated by specialized working groups, with an open interaction.
- Each working group, led by a small pilot group of coorganizers (Senegal and CME),
- This pilot group is supported by a wider circle of strategic partners, organizations and countries, to be identified through an open and transparent process



"DAKAR 2021" A NEW CONCEPT OF WWF








"DAKAR 2021": OPERATIONAL FRAMEWORK







DAKAR 2021 INITIATIVE»



- Labeled support projects, for tangible results to be presented at the forum in 2021:
 - By 2021 at least two thousand and twenty one communities in each region of the world, where applicable, will have access to portable water and decent sanitation (SDG 6.1 6.2);
 - By 2021 at least two thousand and twenty one schools in each region of the world will have water and decent sanitation;
 - By 2021 at least two thousand and twenty one water professionals will be trained to close the capacity gap;
 - By 2021, Transboundary River Basins organizations will adopt at least twenty one communities to provide them with portable water and sanitation;
 - By 2021, at least 5 River Basins per region will have legal protocol;
 - By 2021, an international water fund (Blue Fund) is established.



«DAKAR 2021»: ROADMAP



- Signature of the WWF9 Framework Agreement, June 22nd in Dakar (WWC BoG meeting).
- First Consultation and Planning Workshop on WWF9, (June 25-26, 2018 in Dakar).
- Establishment Organizational bodies of WWF9 (General Delegation, ISC, Secretariat).
- "Kick off meeting" and "Stakeholder Consultation Meeting", 2 years before WWF9



«DAKAR 2021»: ROADMAP



- By the end of September 2018, for each thematic priority, a call for candidates / partners / preparatory meetings.
- At least four preparatory meetings will be organized before February 2019.
- ► A kick-off meeting in Senegal at least 24 months before the 9th World Water Forum (setting up a detailed framework and multi-level working groups).
- ► From April 2019 to February 2020 short-term results and long-term objectives will be defined through meetings and collective exchanges around the world or on a virtual platform.



«DAKAR 2021»: ROADMAP



- A schedule of the week of the Forum will be available 18 months before the event.
- ► A second stakeholder consultation meeting will be held at least 12 months prior to 9WWF. It could be replaced by smaller regional meetings.
- From April 2020 to February 2021, the development of the program, the organization of the event and the synthesis of progress.
- ▶ In March 2021 at the 9th WWF, will be presented the answers and the final results to lead to concrete initiatives and demonstrative responses.
- ► Results monitoring and evaluation mechanisms will be put in place to capitalize on the progress of the 9th to 10th WWF.
