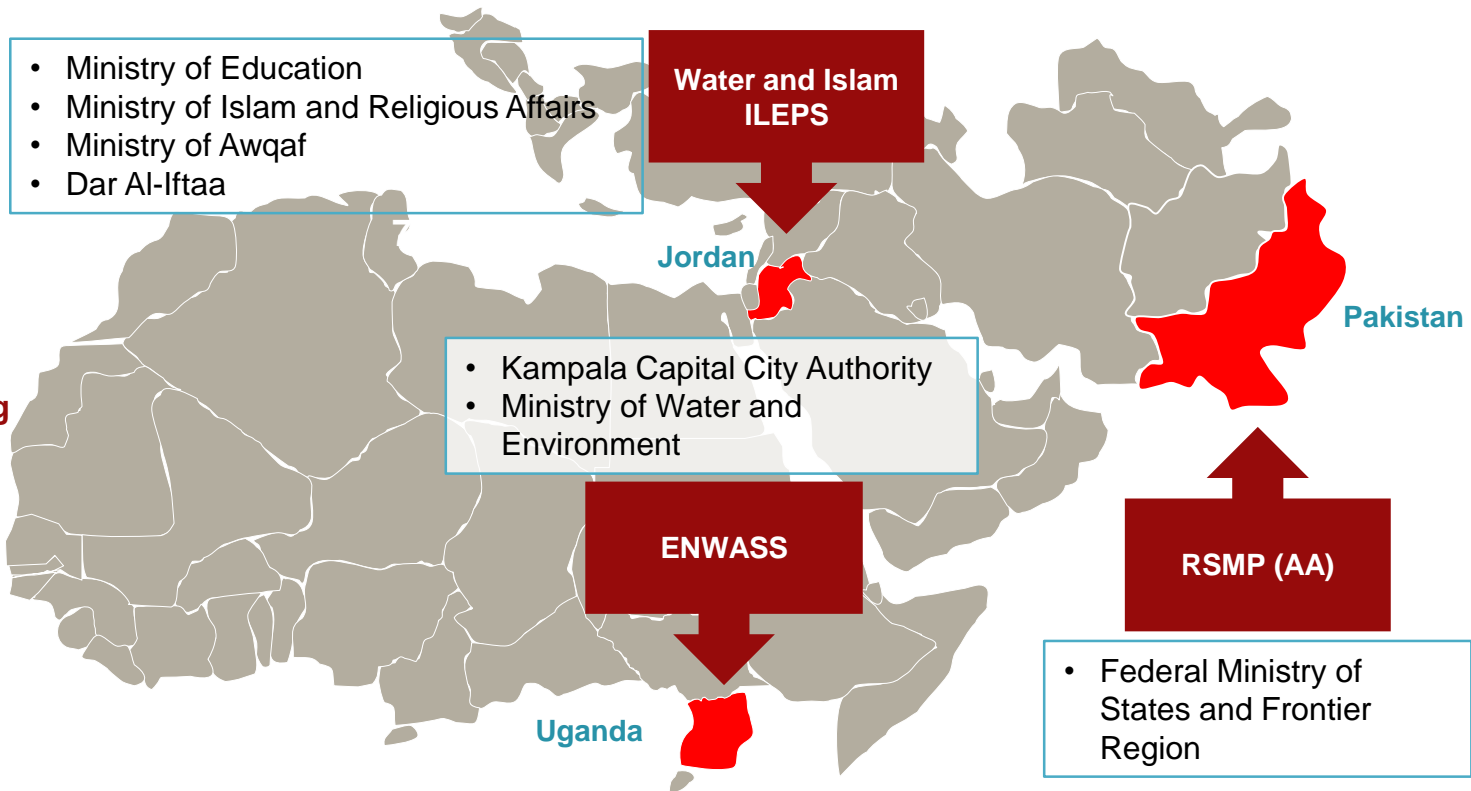


Sanitation: a cross-cutting issue that needs diverse solutions and partners

Sanitation for Millions – A Multi-Donor Initiative launched by BMZ to reach 30 Mio. People

- Four lines of intervention

1. Sanitation and hygiene promotion in schools



2. Provision of public sanitation services in public places, health centers,
and religious institutions



3. Sustainable O&M along the sanitation chain as well as employment
creation



4. Mobilisation of finance and upscaling

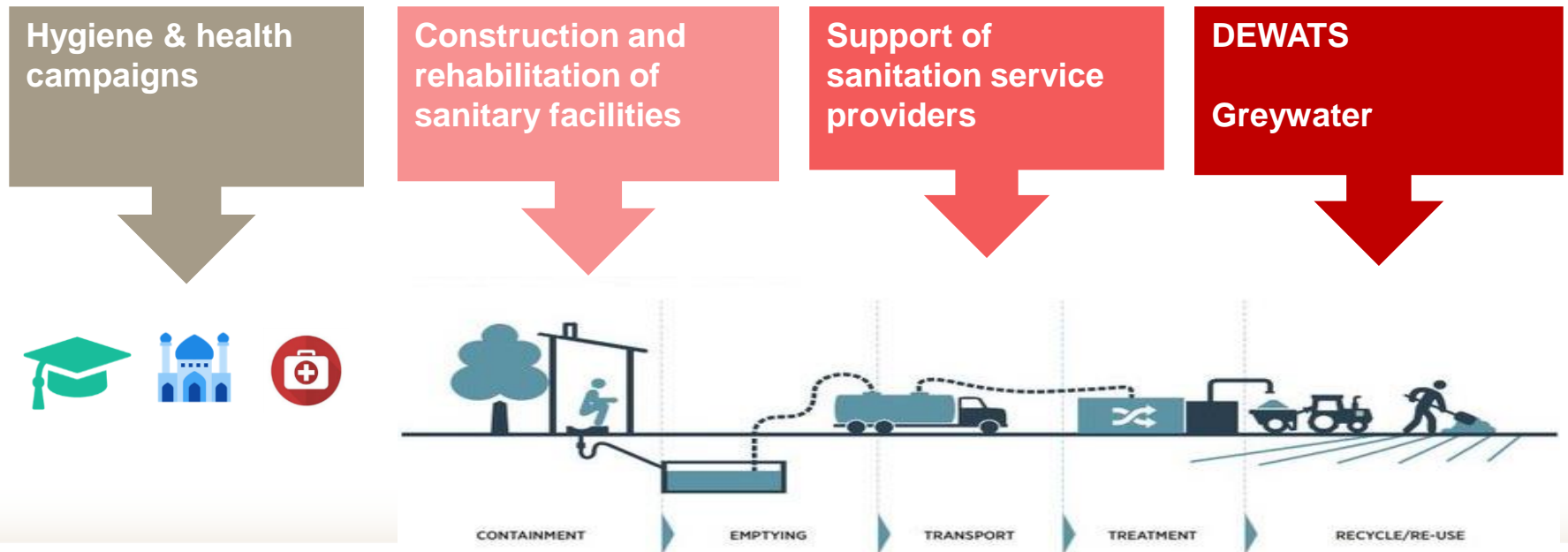
