

Deforestation is Detrimental to Sustainable Hydropower






Hydropower Operators are in a Tight Spot

- Forest loss in tropical ecosystems create massive sedimentation management issues that also threaten the longevity of operators' reservoir "batteries".
- Less predictable weather patterns caused by climate change further exacerbate the loss of flow regularity caused by deforestation, which upends long-term hydrological models and power generation capacity.

Solution: Cloud Forest Pay-for-Success Mechanism

 60mm hectares of degraded cloud forests in Latin America overlap with hydropower watersheds

Climate

- Equates to 2.4 GT CO2


Socio-Economic

Stage 2: Implementation

USD 30+ billion (commercial finance)
