Why publish through the Rural Water Supply Network (RWSN)?

We are <u>the</u> global network dedicated to universal access to safe drinking water in rural areas. We have over 11,000 members in 160+ countries – most of whom are practitioners and managers looking for high quality guidance and experience-sharing on rural water supply. RWSN Blog Post

Length: 400-800 words

Good for:

- Publishing quickly and cheaply
- Short experiences, opinion pieces or linked to an event.
- Provoking debate

Limitations:

- Short shelf-life
- Not available offline
- Not peer-reviewed

Our rules:

- We don't accept commercialstyle sales pitches
- You can be provocative but remain respectful

RWSN Webinar / RWSN Talk

Length: 10-20 minutes

Good for:

- Raising awareness about a project, method or experience
- Engages audiences who are less likely to read reports
- Can be integrated into training

Limitations:

- Not peer-reviewed
- Production costs
- Limited number an annually

Our rules:

- We don't accept commercialstyle sales pitches
- You can be provocative but remain respectful

RWSN Field Note

Length: 8-16 pages

Good for:

- Capturing lessons learned from a particular experience, programme or research study
- Long shelf-life printed publications

Limitations:

- Peer review process, editing and layout takes several months
- Production and printing costs

Our rules:

 Focus on issues from your experiences with broader implications or applications

RWSN Guidance Manual

Length: ideally 16-32 pages

Good for:

- Trusted, peer-reviewed guidance that will be used by professionals in their day-jobs
- Long shelf-life printed publications

Limitations:

- Slowest production time due to writing, review, editing and layout process
- Production and printing costs

Our rules:

 Keep it clear, concise and practical

RWSN Forum Paper / Poster Film

Length: set by Forum criteria

Good for:

- Sharing major developments or trends in rural water supply
- Trusted, peer-reviewed information.

Limitations:

 This option is only available in connection to RWSN Forum conferences, which are every 5 years

Our rules:

 We like practitioners to document their work rigorously and having academics write about practical issues



RWSN publications are free online and to download. Printed versions are not sold so costs need to be covered by upfront funding or donations.
