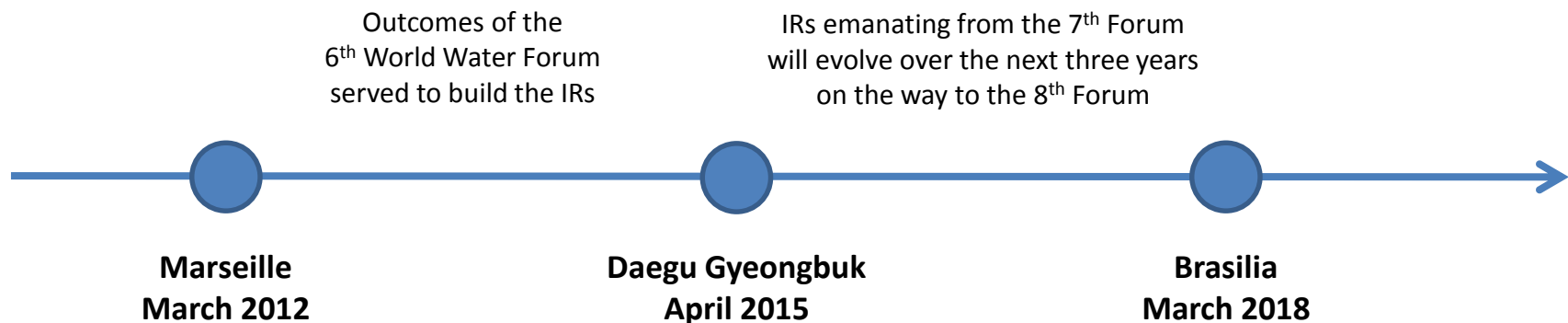

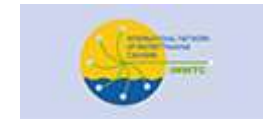

All parties involved commit to ensure that **16 Implementation Roadmaps (IRs)** are met through an agenda for action for the next 3 years and the Action Monitoring System



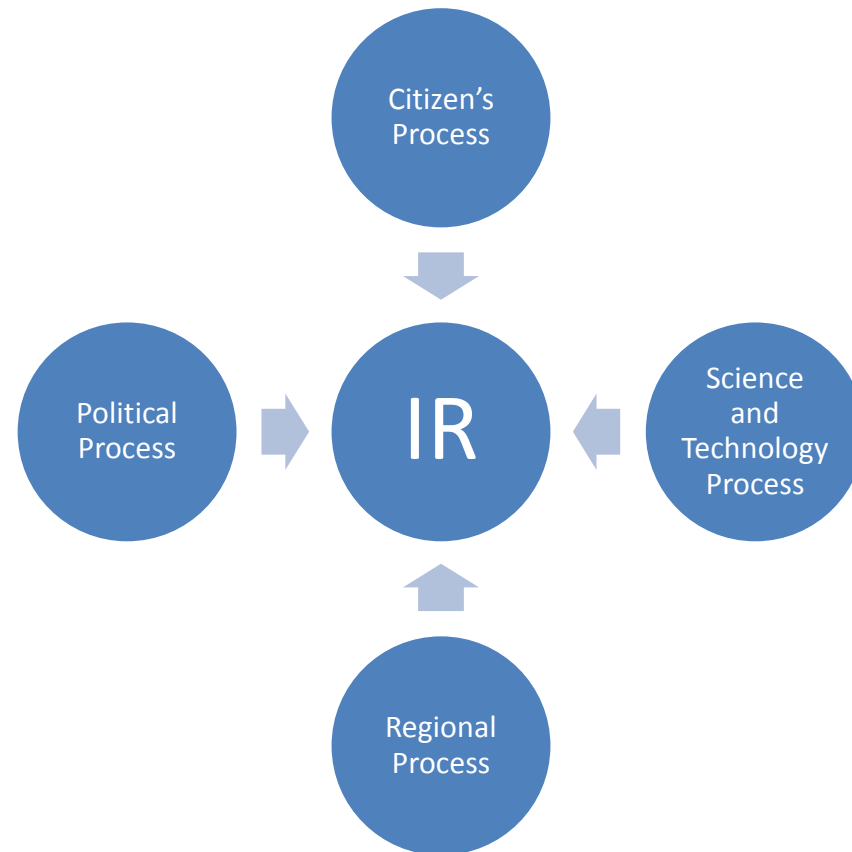

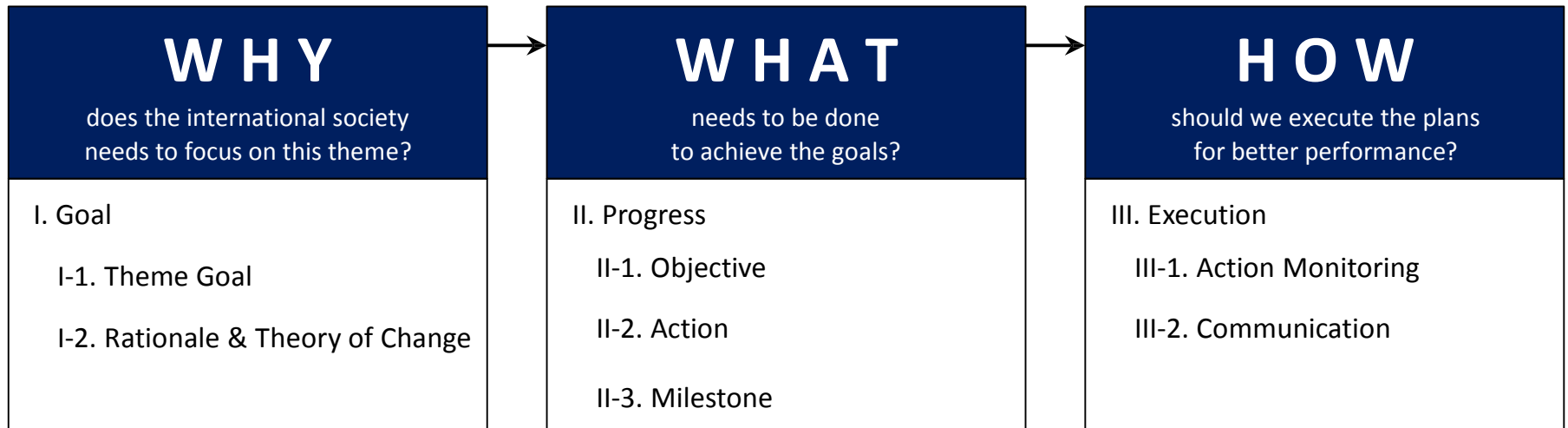

## LINKAGE TO SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS

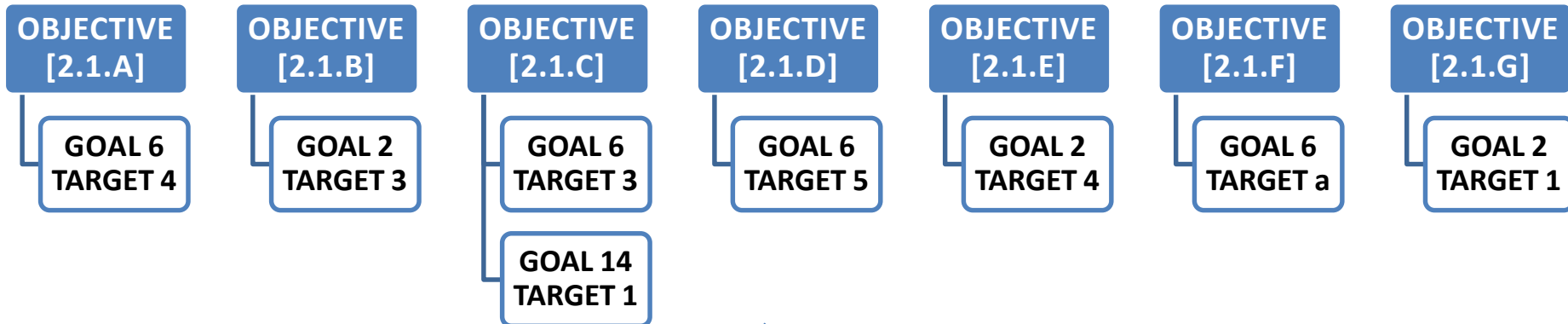
- IR objectives have potential linkages with the drafted SDG targets and can contribute to supporting SDG implementation, not only for the dedicated water goal.
- Approximately 99% of the IRs can be coherently linked to the Sustainable Development Goals
- This demonstrates that water is transversal to all the 17 Goals

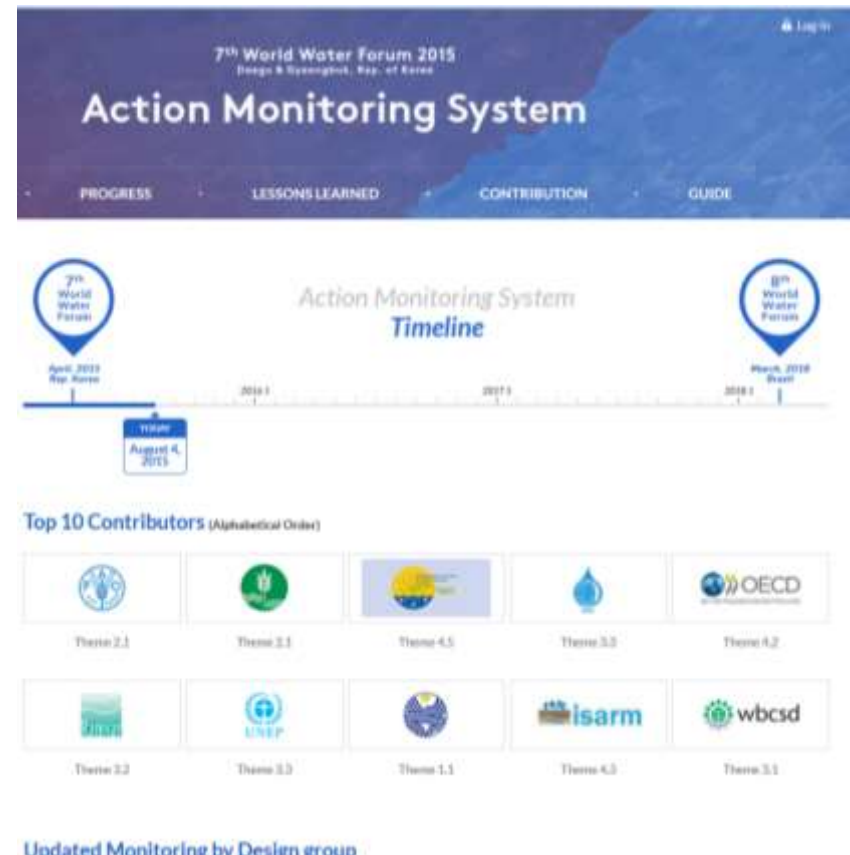
