GLOBAL PERSPECTIVE

- Need a more political dimension
- Pre and post forum communication is vital
- Last minute logistical problems proved very challenging
- > Need wider diversity and balance of representation
- Languages (website, preparatory documents, sessions...)



VENUE AND LOGISTICS

- Make it easy for participants to find their way around
- Use technology to improve audience experience in big session halls
- The environmental impact of the event could be improved
- > Catering for a global audience

POLITICAL PROCESS

- Finding effective ways to engage political actors between Forums remains a challenge
- Ministerial visibility can result in less focus on parliamentarian and LRA processes
- The ministerial roundtable mechanism was positively received
- Connectivity between political processes
- Opportunity to strengthen as central Forum feature





CHALLENGE THINKING



THEMATIC PROCESS

- > Backbone of the Forum
- > Too many sessions with uneven quality
- Lack of Southern partner representation in some sessions
- Integrating divergent and different perspectives





ENGAGE DEBATE



REGIONAL PROCESS

- Strong thematic focus, but perceived lack of political leadership
- Diversity and balance of representation
- > Inter-regional sessions were a welcome innovation
- Confusion between cross-regions and inter-regional processes
- > Integration with other processess



CITIZENS FORUM AND EXPO

- Very popular places for interaction
- Drives the 'numbers'
- Wide engagement of civil society requires investment
- Growing demand
